The brand Heidenau is a famous tire among motorbike world travelers. It is particularly famous because of a big mileage of around 13'000 – 16'000km. For bigger engines (like BMW 700/800/1200f or Africa Twin etc.), there are only Heidenau tires available.

Characteristics K60 Scout: the all-terrain - enduro tire

Through changes at the tread and carcass, the K60 Scout brings better performance on and off road. With the improved tread and compound, the Scout delivers better cornering stability and wet weather grip on the pavement, but like his predecessor delivers off road as well.
